"Has anyone in this class ever heard God?" When nobody spoke for the third time, he simply stated, "Then there is no God!"


One of the students did not like the sound of this and asked for permission to speak. The professor granted it, and the student stood up and asked, "Has anyone in this class seen our professor's brain?"



Why do Catholics celebrate the Feast of the Presentation?

This feast day celebrates both the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple and the Purification of Mary, which was required by the Mosaic Law 40 days after the birth of a child. The Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2, also called Candlemas for the custom of using lighted candles. In the early Church, it was often celebrated on February 14, 40 days after the Epiphany, in keeping with the practice of celebrating Christmas on that date in the East. Among the Orthodox, it is known as the Hypapante ("Meeting" of the Lord with Simeon).

¿Por qué los católicos celebran la Fiesta de la Presentación?

Esta fiesta celebra tanto la Presentación de Jesús en el Templo como la Purificación de María, que la Ley Mosaica exigía que se produjera 40 días después del nacimiento de un niño. La Iglesia celebra la Fiesta de la Presentación del Señor el 2 de febrero, también llamada la Candelaria por la costumbre de utilizar velas encendidas. En la Iglesia primitiva, se celebraba a menudo el 14 de febrero, 40 días después de la Epifanía, en consonancia con la práctica de celebrar la Navidad en esa fecha en Oriente. Entre los ortodoxos, se la conoce como Hypapante ("Encuentro" del Señor con Simeón).

Never Lose a Sense of Joy Courtesy of Minute Meditations/Franciscan Media

Joy sees the world as God intended; it is a reaction to all God is doing in our lives now and in the future. It is a choice we make based on the knowledge that God loves us and is with us through all our life experiences.

One simple way to increase joy is to smile more. You may feel awkward at first, but it works. Start by imagining yourself smiling happily, like a child playing on a swing set or jumping in the ocean waves. Then practice it in the mirror — a great big toothy grin. A genuine smile involves the eyes and the mouth. It releases stress-lowering neurotransmitters like serotonin and dopamine into the bloodstream. This means that smiling begets more smiling. It reminds us that there is still joy in life.
